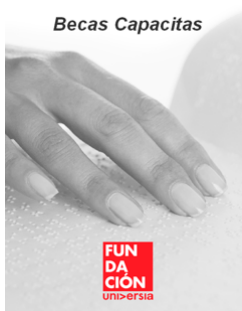
### Erasmus Scholarships: Students

## FARO GLOBAL Scholarships



The FARO Global Scholarships program promotes the mobility of final year students from all Spanish universities through quality internships at companies in Europe, Asia, the United States and Canada. The goal of the program is to help students find professional employment by enhancing their skills, aptitudes and attitudes.

The scholarships are awarded continuously over the lifetime of the program which will finish with the return of the last intern on 31 December 2010. A scholarship lasts seven months on average.

## Asia-Pacific Scholarships



The **ICO Foundation** is inviting applications until **15 March** for scholarships for graduates to spend time in countries in **Asia and the Pacific**. The goal of this scholarship program is to improve the chosen candidates' Mandarin Chinese language skills.

The general program consists of a theoretical and practical course which combines language immersion with in-depth analysis of economic and business aspects of Chinese society. However, there is a choice of three kinds of scholarship: immersion in Chinese culture, language and economics, and summer programs.

The grant is essentially aimed at graduates in Business Administration, Economics, Law, International Trade and Telecommunications Engineering.

## Carolina Foundation Education Program:



The Carolina Foundation Education Program seeks to help university graduates pursue further studies and enable postgraduates, teachers, researchers, artists and professionals from Latin America to specialise and update their knowledge.

The Carolina Foundation offers three kinds of educational scholarships: postgraduate, doctoral and short-term post-doctoral fellowships, and lifelong learning grants. The latter is open to both Latin Americans and Spaniards.

A total of 1,719 scholarships and grants were offered by the Foundation's Education Program in 2008–2009.
